






## **Cost Of Living**

After a year and a half of the Albanese government, Australian households continue to bear the brunt of a cost of living crisis that continues to get worse and worse, not better.

Despite promises before the election to deliver 'cheaper mortgages', 12 interest rate rises now mean a family with a \$750,000 mortgage is paying \$22,000 a year more on their mortgage.

And despite the promise of a \$275 annual reduction on power bills, gas and electricity prices continue to grow, making life harder not only for households but also for small businesses, leading to higher inflation across the economy.

While the government has been focussed on other issues - like the Voice referendum - life has been getting harder for Australian families, with new OECD data showing Australia experiencing the worst collapse of real household income in the developed world.

In Parliament, I have continued to speak out about Labor's broken promises in these areas and will continue to hold them to account on your behalf.

#### **First Home Buyers**

As the Shadow Minister for Housing, I have recommitted that the Coalition will allow first home buyers to access a portion of their own superannuation to help with the deposit hurdle when purchasing a new home.

It will mean Australians can buy their first home sooner by slashing the time taken to save a deposit by three years, on average.



# **Local Infrastructure Cuts**

The Albanese government continues to threaten to cut funding for important local road projects, including the upgrade of additional lanes on Canterbury Road and the Tortice Drive and Warrandyte Road intersection upgrade.

This is in addition to Labor's cancellation of the \$50 million Dorset Road upgrade and the Heatherdale Station Carpark.
