
Norwood Senior Football Club

Canberra Update



Cost Of Living

After one year of the Albanese government, many Australians will be feeling as though they are under significantly more financial stress.

Before the election, the Prime Minister promised Australians would be better off under Labor. He promised cheaper power prices along with 'cheaper mortgages' and higher wages.

Instead, energy prices are skyrocketing, families are suffering under 11 interest rate rises, and real wages are going backwards as the cost of living continues to get worse.

On top of this, Labor's recent budget poured fuel on the inflation fire, meaning mortgages and prices will remain higher for longer. As a result, Australians with a mortgage of \$750,000 are now paying \$1,856 more each month or more than \$22,000 extra per year.





POWER SURGE AS BILLS UP BY 45%

Power prices have risen by nearly 50 per cent for some households, new billing data shows. At the same time, power prices are tipped to surge by 45 per cent this year, despite the Prime Minister promising 97 times during the election that your power bills would reduce by \$275.

In Parliament, I've spoken about Labor's broken promises in these areas and how this is impacting members of our community.

Trip to India

After working closely with our local Burmese community for 10 years, I travelled with local community leaders to the India/Burma border region to see firsthand the issues faced by Burmese refugees and displaced people. I also used it as an opportunity to forge even closer ties between Australia and India.


