


Dorset Road, Croydon

- X \$15 million for the **Heatherdale Train Station**Carpark

Previously committed funding has also not been delivered for other important community infrastructure upgrades including local tennis, football and netball clubs as well as school facilities.

Labor has a history of cancelling projects in the eastern suburbs, and I can assure you I will keep fighting for the upgrades we so desperately need.
